If we get this rake it comes with a 90 day warranty also. John Finch responded to Councilman Weingartner saying it's either a 2009 or 2010, it goes by the VIN number. Councilman Diffendorf asked if we have one of these rakes now. John Finch said we have two of these rakes. One for Veteran's River Park which is from 1998 and is in rough shape and has been flooded twice. I'm not sure how much more we are
