Councilman Diffendorf moved to adopt resolution declaring road project bond as Type II action for SEQRA purposes with no further action required by the Town, in accordance with the attached resolution. Councilman Grubham seconded.

Councilwoman Yonchuk moved to adopt Bond Resolution of the Town of Kirkwood, New York, adopted February 27, 2018, authorizing the construction of road improvements, including drainage and ditching related thereto, stating the estimated maximum cost thereof is \$1,924,100, appropriating said amount for such purpose, including grant funds expected to be received from the State of New York in the amount of \$400,000 and \$64,100 in funds of the Town available for such purpose; and authorizing the issuance of bonds in the principal amount of not to exceed \$1,464,000 to finance the balance of said appropriation, in accordance with the attached resolution. Councilman Diffendorf seconded.

**Discussion:** Supervisor Kniffen explained this is in regard to the new road project. He said that normally late in the year the Highway Superintendent presents to the Board a list of roads that he wants to work on the next year and as the new Superintendent, John Finch questioned if there wasn't something we could do that's more expansive and that is what we're doing. He said it will take a while and we will be doing things so there won't be so much maintenance required. Supervisor Kniffen said we received \$400,000 through Senator Akshar's office towards this project and the rest will be bonded for. He noted that taxes will not be going up.
