Supervisor Grubham opened the meeting by reporting that property taxes will have a 0% increase for 2022. Since the Town has had good luck with sales tax money coming in that helped offset any increase in taxes.

On a separate note, Supervisor Grubham explained that sales tax money is doled out by population numbers, and with Kirkwood losing about 6% in population during the last census tally the Town's sales tax money will go down by 6% as well. That number will stay in place for the next 10 years until the next census is conducted.

Supervisor Grubham opened the hearing to public comment. Hearing no comments, he closed the hearing at 6:04 PM.
