 Discussion – Resolution awarding the Sealed Bid for the Stratmill Road Water Tank Rehabilitation Project to R. DeVincentis Construction, Inc., being the lowest responsible bidder at \$220,000, broken down as follows:

Item A: \$12,000 - Concrete Dome Repair

Item B: \$120,000 – Cleaning Exterior Tank & Repainting

Item C: \$48,000 – Cleaning Interior Tank
Item E: \$12,000 – Cleaning Interior Piping
Item F: \$30,000 – Access Dome Hatch

It was decided that Item D (Waterproof Coating Interior Tank) would not be completed at this time for budget reasons.

2. Discussion – Road Work. (LCG)

In addition to the already approved paving roadwork for 2023, Supervisor Grubham discussed a few other roads that could get paved this year. If agreed upon, Krager Road would be paved and Johnson Road will be two-thirds complete this year. A list of the suggested road projects is on file in the Town Clerk's office. *Resolution*.

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3. Summer Schedule: (LCG)

Resolution combining the June 27, 2023 Work Session and the July 3, 2023 Town Board Meeting into one night to be held Monday, June 26, 2023.

Resolution combining the July 25, 2023 Work Session and the August 1, 2023 Town Board Meeting into one night to be held August 1, 2023.

Resolution combining the August 29, 2023 Work Session and the September 5, 2023 Town Board Meeting into one night to be held September 5, 2023.

- 4. Resolution scheduling a Special Town Board Meeting for December 26, 2023, after the Work Session, for the purpose of auditing year end bills and any other business that may come before the Board. (LCG)
- 5. Discussion pursuant to section 3A(e) of Local Law No. 2-1979 entitled "A Local Law Regulating the Use of Parks of the Town of Kirkwood", authorizing the Town Clerk to issue a permit to the Kirkwood Town Fair, Inc., for the use of the entire Kirkwood Veterans River Park on August 10, 11, and 12, 2023 without any permit fee to guarantee proper clean up after each use. (LCG)

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7. Discussion – Resolution ratifying a resolution authorizing the Supervisor to sign the Light Emitting Diode Street Light Conversion Letter Agreement with NYSEG, regarding a light on Barlow Road, in accordance with the attached agreement. (LCG)

Councilmember Diffendorf reiterated that this new LED light will save the Town a lot of money.

- 8. Discussion Resolution approving the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution for Elected and Appointed Officials for Michael Mucci as Justice of the Peace and Marchie Diffendorf as Planning Board Chair, in accordance with the attached resolution. (LCG)
- 9. Discussion Installation of new door and frame at Code Building. (LCG) Supervisor Grubham explained the door is very hard to open, it rusted out, and needs to be fixed as soon as possible. *Resolution*.
- Discussion Humane Society Fundraiser September 30, 2023 River Park. (SMW)

Councilmember Sandy Wasson is working with the Humane Society to get the Cruising for Paws fundraiser set up at Veterans River Park on September 30, 2023. Attractions include a car show, crafts, a band or DJ, and non-profit food selections. The Humane Society will be sending in a Facilities Use form with insurance. *Resolution*.

11. Discussion – Resolution ratifying a resolution hiring Matthew Loftus as Water/Wastewater Maintainer to work in the Water & Sewer Department, effective April 25, 2023, at a rate of pay of \$22.00 per hour. (JAF)
