## **Brush Pick-Up**

Brush/branches <u>CAN</u> be put on the roadside to be picked up:

## NO THORNS OR BRIARS

- 1. No longer than 6 feet, weighing no more than 50 pounds with all branches in one direction.
- 2. Only limited amounts of brush can be picked up at any location.
- 3. Anything over 3 inches in diameter is not considered brush.





## The Following will NOT be collected:

- 1. Waste from Tree Removal or Site Cleaning
- 2. No Flood Debris or Construction Materials.
