Supervisor Grubham opened the hearing to public comments. Hearing none, he closed the hearing at 6:03 PM.

After the work session, Supervisor Grubham reopened the hearing at 7 PM to give Greg Fish of Grosset Drive a chance to speak since he arrived shortly after the public hearing was closed.

Greg Fish asked for an explanation of the price increase of his water assessment. Mr. McKertich explained that he has moved from Tier 6 to Tier 5 in the unit assessment due to an increase in the amount of water that has been used over the last year. Because of that increase in water you have moved to a new Tier and that means you have more units assessed to you, an increase from 5 units to 10 units, which is approximately \$200 a year.

Supervisor Grubham closed the hearing at 7:03 PM.
