# **Street Light Fixed.**

Councilmember Diffendorf reported the street light on the corner of Trim Street and Route 11 is now fixed, it wasn't easy to get done but NYSEG finally took care of it.

# **Dog Control Report.**

Councilmember Legg reported numbers from the January 2025 Dog Control Report.

# Youth Sports and Recreation Report.

Councilmember Legg conveyed information on the Youth Program for Devin Fleetwood. Spring sports registration is now open until March 15, 2025, this is for baseball, softball, and tee ball. Two indoor winter league soccer teams have been playing at the 434 complex in Vestal. Devin was interviewed on FOX 40 news regarding youth sports programs in conjunction with NYS grant programs, this will air sometime in the near future. Basketball season is in full swing with about 50 kids participating.

# Sewer Break.

Supervisor Grubham explained there was an emergency sewer break in the Colpitts Track area (24 Howard Street) today. The Town hired outside help to fix the break because the town employees were out plowing snow.

# **Sewage Pumping Station.**

Supervisor Grubham reported that a pump failed last week at the sewage pumping station, although one pump is on order it was supposed to replace a different pump and it won't be here for a month, so the station is down to two pumps. He suggested another pump get ordered now so there is one on hand in case it is needed. The pump cost \$20,000, there is money in the budget.

# Varidox System.

After some research, Al Glover discovered the Varidox system that was discussed at the last work session (to remove Iron and Manganese from the water system) was determined to be 30 years old and not up to date so unfortunately unusable to the Town now.

# Historian Update.

Karen Ferguson notified the Board that she has started the process of another historical marker in conjunction with the Sons of the American Revolution. It will be a Patriot Burial Marker for the Riverside Cemetery where there are at least two Revolutionary War soldiers buried, one of which is John Conklin. Karen also informed the Board that she has been asked to be a guest speaker in the next few weeks for the Daughters of the American Revolution.
